1. Who/ What do we vote for in Philippine Elections?
2. Can a citizen be forced to register?

5. Can the vote of one voter carry more weight than others?

- We vote for/ in 3 Ps
 1. Persons (*Natural and Juridical, Regular and and Special Elections – Vacancy in Congress, Recall, Postponement and Failure of Elections*)
 2. Policies (*Initiative and Referendum*)
 3. Plebiscites (*LGU creation, dissolution, upgrade/ downgrade, conversion*)
- Suffrage is now a **right**
 - Right to Register or not
 - Right to Vote or not
 - No longer an obligation
 - Prior to the 1987 Constitution, not voting was an election offense
- **Vote-buying and Vote-selling** are election offenses
- Vote of a voter has **same weight** as others
