

3) Suffrage: Qualifications of Voters

- 1. Filipino citizen
- 2. At least 18 yo on election day
- 3. Resident in Philippines for at least 1 year prior to election (domicile or permanent residency)
- 4. Resident in place where propose to vote for 6 months prior to election day (domicile, permanent or temporary residency)
- 5. Not disqualified
- 6. To vote, must be registered

- Right to Register vs.Right to Vote
- Found in the Constitution
- Reckoning period is election day
- oList finite/ exclusive
- No substantive requirements

RULES ON CERTIFICATES OF CANDIDACY (COCS) ASPIRANT VS. CANDIDATE

Who is an ASPIRANT?	A person who has the intention of seeking public elective office and who has filed his/her CoC, using the prescribed form, with the proper office within the period set.
When does an ASPIRANT become a CANDIDATE?	A person who has filed a CoC (Aspirant) only becomes a candidate for the elective position sought at the start of the campaign period.
Why is this distinction important?	Unlawful acts or omissions applicable to a candidate (like campaigning and expenditures) shall only apply upon the start of the campaign period.
When is the deadline to file COCs?	5:00 p.m., Tuesday, October 8, 2024 (Period to file is October 1 to 8, 2024)

WHO ARE INDEPENDENT **ASPIRANTS/CANDIDATES?**

NO OR IMPROPER NOMINATION

- 1. Not nominated by a registered party/ coalition
- 2. Nominated by an unregistered party/coalition
- 3. Repudiated nomination
- 4. Nominated by ≥ 1 registered party/ coalition

IRREGULAR CONA (CERTIFICATE OF NOMINATION AND ACCEPTANCE)

- 1. CONA filed after deadline to file CoC
- 2. CoC and CONA for different positions
- 3. Cancelled CONA
- 4. CONA signed by an unregistered person
- 5. CONA signed by an unauthorized person
- 6. CONA signed by an individual member of a coalition
- 7. Authorized signatory nominated more than the number of candidates for contested position

EFFECTS IF INDEPENDENT

- 1. An independent aspirant/candidate cannot be substituted.
- 2. "IND" will appear beside name in Ballot.
- 3. Appoint a watcher in venue where CoCs are filed/ [Polling Place].
- 4. Spend PhP5/ voter (not just PhP3) for the May 2025 elections.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Kindly fill-out the information and submit to the Law Department, on or before September 30, 2024.
- Additional sheets may be used in case of more than five (5) authorized signatories.
- 3. The President/Chairperson/Secretary-General shall sign each page of the Sworn List of Authorized Signatories.
- 4. The List shall be sworn before a notary public or any official authorized to administer oath. COMELEC officials are not authorized to administer oath, even in their capacities as Notary Public.
- 5. No filing fee shall be imposed.

RULES ON CERTIFICATES OF CANDIDACY: SUBSTITUTION

CoC Series No. 3, September 2, 2024 | COMELEC Resolution No. 11045 (August 28, 2024)

GROUNDS	Withdrawal, Death and Disqualification (DQ) by Final Judgment*
DEADLINES FOR SUBMISSION	If Original Aspirant withdraws: October 8, 2024 If Original Aspirant/ Candidate dies or is disqualified: Midday, May 12, 2025
EFFECTS	 Original Aspirant/ Candidate will no longer be an Aspirant/ Candidate and the Substitute will become the Aspirant/ Candidate. Name in Ballot: If due to withdrawal: Name of Substitute Aspirant will appear in Ballot. If death or DQ happens between: October 9 to November 15, 2024 – Name of Substitute will appear in Ballot. ii.November 16, 2024 to mid-day of May 12, 2025 – Name of Original Candidate will appear in Ballot. To be voted upon, the Substitute must have the same surname as Original.

REQUIREMENTS	 The Original Aspirant/ Candidate must not be an Independent Aspirant/ Candidate. The Substitute must belong to same party as the Original. The Substitute must be qualified. If due to withdrawal, the Statement of Withdrawal by the Original Aspirant must include the name of the Substitute. If due to death, the Substitute shall submit the death certificate of the Original Aspirant/ Candidate.
PROCEDURES	 1.The Substitute must file his/ her CoC with Certificate of Nomination and Acceptance (CONA) with the appropriate COMELEC Office. 2.If die/ DQ'd between May 11 – 12 (mid-day), 2025 file CoC with Electoral Board/ COMELEC Local Office. 3.COMELEC En banc to resolve substitution for national positions. 4.COMELEC Law Department to act on substitution for local positions.

- oWhat Offenses? Enumerated in Section 68 OEC (2 options DQ case or Election Offense criminal case): Vote-Buying; Terrorism, Unlawful Expenditures, Unlawful Campaign, Coercion of Subordinates, Threats, Prohibition against Release of Public Funds
- OWhere File? Comelec Division
- **OWhen File?** Before Proclamation
- olf Not File? Election Protest; Election Offense

4) Disqualifications: Nuisance

- Petition? Petition to Declare a Candidate a Nuisance Candidate
- Who Is/ Considerations? Campaign Capability, Intention,
 Performance, Exposure, Platform, Party Affiliation,
 Organization, Profession, Income, Health, Education, Name
 - Not Grounds: unpopularity and being an independent candidate; lack of financial resources to wage a campaign
- OWho Files? Real Parties-in-Interest (similar names)
- OWhere File? Comelec Division
- When File? Within 5 days from Last Day of Filing of Certificate of Candidacy (October 13, 2024) | from filing of CoC
- olf Not File? No remedy

4) Disqualifications: Material Misrepresentation

- OWhat? Petition to Deny Due Course or Cancel a CoC
- Elements?
 - Misrepresentation: Not true (facts which are true to the best knowledge of candidate)
 - Material: pertains to Qualifications and Disqualifications (e.g. residency) | knew conviction of crime involving moral turpitude (libel) | violation of 3-term rule
 - onot material if pertaining to surname, profession, political party affiliation, civil status, legitimacy
 - Willful/ Deliberate Intent to defraud voters
 - Candidate not actually qualified
- OWhere File? Comelec Division
- OWhen File? 25 days from Filing of CoC

4) Sanctions against Local Officials



DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS AGAINST AND CANDIDACIES OF LOCAL ELECTIVE OFFICIALS

- 1. No investigation during the election period.
- 2. No suspension during the election period unless with COMELEC approval.
- 3. No preventive suspension during the election period.
- 4. No recall on the last year.
- 5. No condonation because of re-election.

5) Certificate of Candidacy (CoC)




Law does **not** demand from candidates **perfect** accuracy/ absolute certainty in the information that they supply in a CoC, but only such facts which they believe to be true to the best of their knowledge.

5) Certificate of Candidacy (CoC)

- ○No CoC = Cannot run
- on person = 1 CoC (withdraw other CoCs if filed > 1)
- File personally or through authorized representative (SPA) (not mail, email or fax)
- oIf filed in due form (no patent defects/ blanks), COMELEC ministerial duty to receive COC (if incomplete, not stamped "Received")
- Olf filed in wrong office = deemed not filed (Law Department, ORED, OPES or OEO)
- Companions (maximum): Senators 4, others 3
- Posting of CoCs and CONAs: Starting October 18, 2024

10 DECLARATIONS

CoC Series No. 6, September 5, 2024 | COMELEC Resolution No. 11045 (August 28, 2024)

- 1. I am eligible for the office I seek to be elected to.
- 2. I am a (natural-born) Filipino citizen
- 3. I am not a permanent resident of, or an immigrant to, a foreign country.
- 4. I executed a sworn renunciation of foreign citizenship. (If applicable, attach a copy.)
- An aspirant/candidate must possess all the qualifications age, citizenship, residency, a registered voter and able to read and write and none of the disqualifications – foreign citizenship and permanent residency elsewhere, etc.
- If not qualified and if there is misrepresentation in the CoC, his/ her CoC may be cancelled.
- 5. I will file, with the Office of the Commission, within thirty (30) days after election day, my full, true and itemized Statement of Contributions and Expenditures (SOCE) in connection with the elections.
- A candidate must account his/her electoral contributions and expenditures.
- Those who do not file the SOCE are not allowed to assume office and may be sanctioned.
- A candidate who spends beyond the limit may be disqualified.

- 6. I shall abide by the rules and regulations of the Commission, including its code of conduct on social media.
- COMELEC can issue rules on the use of social media as a form of campaigning.
- Proponents of fake news may be prosecuted and may be disqualified.
- 7. I shall not advocate violence or unlawful means to achieve my goals.
- 8. I will support and defend the Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines and will maintain true faith and allegiance thereto. I will obey the laws, legal orders, and decrees promulgated by the duly constituted authorities.
- A candidate may be disqualified for committing acts of terrorism.
- These declarations are embodied in the Oath of Office.
- Public Officers are obligated to follow the law.
- 9. I give my consent to the Commission on Elections to collect, disclose or share, and process the personal data I provided herein for election and other lawful purposes in accordance with the privacy notice at the back of this form, and as may be authorized by existing laws.
- This promotes transparency and accountability of aspirants and candidates.
- This complies with the Data Privacy Act, provided personal sensitive information is not made public.
- 10. I impose this obligation upon myself voluntarily, without mental reservation or purpose of evasion.
- · Submission of the CoC means consent to these declarations.
